



## COVID 19 RULES FOR ATTENDANCE AT THE WELSH ONE50

All persons attending the WELSH ONE50 must adhere to the following set of guidelines. **These guidelines are constantly being reviewed and updated. This is a live document however please note that we will follow the relevant guidance at the time of the event.**

It is the responsibility of all attendees to manage their own safety as well as the safety of others. The organisers are following a strict regime of Health and Safety measures aimed at limiting the potential spread of COVID 19 in all of its variants. Please show courtesy to the people that are putting themselves at risk to stage the event for you and abide by all instructions given.

### 1. Number of Attendees

The venue will determine the number of attendees allowed on site, to enable the maximum number of competitors there are restrictions in place on size of parties.

#### 1.1 Adult Competitors/Team

**Maximum 6 per team from 2 households.** It's imperative to enable affective track and trace that all team members are declared and do not stray into other "Team Bubbles". Outside of this group, the 2m distancing rule must be observed.

#### 1.2 Spectators

With the exception of limited numbers of invited guests of the organisers, independent spectators will not be permitted at the event.

### 2. Event Entries

Competitors and all team members must book to attend the event in advance, supplying full contact details. All attendees must show proof of ID upon entry IAW track and trace guidelines. All entry money must be paid in advance as no cash will be taken on the event.

### 3. Event Licences

Competitors are requested to arrange in advance to be the holders of either an annual NORA 92 licence or a 2021 One Event Licence Card, both are available through [nora92.com](http://nora92.com)

### 4. Signing On/Drivers Briefs

#### 4.1 Signing On

Only one person at a time will be allowed to attend the sign on desk and facemasks must be worn, competitors are requested to use their own pens for signing on.

## 4.2 Drivers Briefs

Briefs will take place in a well-ventilated area. To enable social distancing, only 1 team member will be able to attend the brief. Drivers briefs will also be live streamed on social media, however 1 representative must attend the physical brief.

## 5. Persons showing symptoms

Any person that has been showing symptoms of the virus within 10 days of the event must not attend unless they have a negative test result.

Any person that develops symptoms of the virus whilst at the venue must inform the organisers and leave the site immediately.

## 6. Rapid COVID 19 Testing and Temperature Testing

### 7.1 Rapid Testing

COVID 19 rapid testing will be a condition of entry to identify possible asymptomatic cases. If any attendees have a positive result both the attendee in question and any further attendees who have been in a close proximity, (traveling together) will be refused access to the site.

### 7.2 Temperature Checks

You may be subjected to a non-contact temperature check prior to being given access to the site.

## 7. Face Coverings/PPE

All attendees must provide relevant PPE for the duration of the event.

Face coverings must always be worn by all persons 11 years old or over when not in the immediate vicinity of their pit area. If you are not wearing a face covering, you will be asked to leave the site immediately.

Exemptions may apply but must be notified to the organiser. **NO MASK – NO ENTRY**

## 8. Social Distancing

The rule of 6 will be in place at the event – person from two households may congregate in groups of no more than six. **Outside of this group, the 2m distancing rule must be observed.**

## 9. Hygiene

Hand sanitiser will be available, it is the responsibility of all attendees to ensure that they regular wash and sanitise their hands.

## 10. Facilities

### 10.1 Toilets

Due to the increased risk of transmission of COVID-19 given the low levels of natural light, lack of ventilation, many surfaces to touch and the purpose of a toilet. Public toilets will not be available on site. Attendees must provide their own, self-contained toilet (caravan) or hire a toilet via the event organisers (see 10.4). Facilities must **not** be shared between those outside team bubbles. NB. No additional toilets will be available on site.

## 10.2 Catering/Camping

Catering will be provided however all attendees are requested to be as self-sufficient as possible.

If visiting the catering facilities all attendees must adhere to strict social distancing measures, including but not limited to, segregated mealtimes and floor markings.

## 10.3 COVID 19 Surcharge (competitors)

To allow the event organisers to put this event on a COVID 19 surcharge must be applied.

### 10.3.1 Per attendee

A charge of **£5** per attendee, this is to be applied to **all attendees** to facilitate Rapid Testing (7.1) in order to keep us all safe. (Non-Refundable)

### 10.3.2 Per Team

A charge of **£35** per team, this will be applied to all teams who cannot provide a self-contained toilet as detailed above (10.1) or any team that wishes to hire toilet facilities.
